PETITION TO THE HOUSE OF COMMONS IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED

We, the undersigned residents of Canada draw the attention of the House to the following:

THAT as there is no credible evidence that the Vancouver drug-injection site achieves any success in having addicts completing treatment, so it is basically a facility to facilitate drug-addiction. Politically correct activists with a hidden agenda and some politicians have failed to see or deliberately and recklessly closed their eyes to the fact that providing a place for drug-addicts to inject themselves with poisonous substances, would only aggravate their addictions and health, trafficking of drugs and property crimes. It can never be safe to have poisonous substance injected into addicts' bodies. At the same time, all three levels of government have not taken the de-tox and treatment aspects seriously and financial resources have not been adequately allocated for such purposes.
